Many hands make light work! Child labour welcome too.

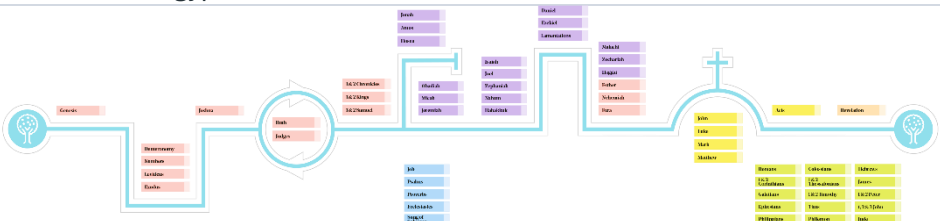
