We are updating our records of those who have DBS certificates and it is apparent that some of us need to renew our DBS applications as either our certificates are now out of date or they are close to coming to the end of their 3 year period of certification.

Later this week I will be sending out email invites to complete a renewal or start a DBS application in the near future to around a dozen or more people. Please do not be concerned, we are simply updating our records and trying to follow good safeguarding practice.

We would be most grateful if you can complete the necessary application details online as soon as it is convenient to you. There are links given for instructions on what to do. However if you find any aspect of the application challenging to complete on your own please let me know and we can arrange a time to complete the application at church using my computer.
