Bearfield Church Walking Group! **Starting – Sunday 3rd May**

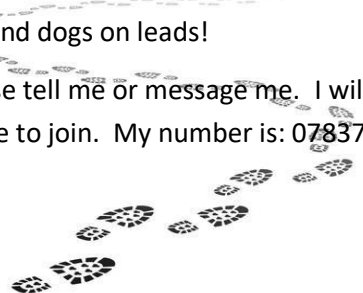
Hi Everyone!

The Climbing Wall

Over 170 young people from the local area use our climbing wall per week, as well as hundreds of local climbers, school groups, scouts, guides, cadets and military organisations. With such heavy use of our climbing facility over the last 30 years, and the development of climbing as a sport, our climbing walls are long overdue a refresh!

We are currently fundraising for the initial stages of our climbing wall development, a £1.5m project that will see the construction of a national-standard climbing facility here at Summit Centre, offering modern lead climbing walls, speed climbing facilities, and grassroots community-driven climbing walls.
