Mission Partner Update

Update from Wiltshire Youth for Christ



First of all, a huge thank you for your ongoing support for us as a church, both in terms of finance and your prayers. We are so encouraged by your partnership, not least because it is true more than ever that all our work must be in fellowship and harmony with local churches. We want to see young people come to know Jesus and be nurtured in churches - that's where they need to be!

This has been a season of challenges and encouragements. The challenges have been around some changes to our team, as staff and volunteers move on and others suffer from illness. We've been reflecting on Jesus' words in John 15: *...every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful.* The pruning is painful but we have a real sense, therefore, that new growth and fruitfulness is coming, with a great harvest among young people.

In terms of encouragements, a major part of our work is in schools and we are continuing to provide chaplaincy one day a week at St Laurence, with the baton passing from Dan Webb to Steve Dewar. This is an amazing open door, with young people eager to come to both open, drop-in sessions and Christian Union. The chaplain is a regular speaker at Collective Worship and has regular slots in both staff and parent newsletters; this is in addition to those opportunities to be present and come alongside both youngsters and staff during the school day.

We are holding a taster / training session for anyone who is interested in becoming a volunteer mentor in a local school on **Saturday 3rd October** in Trowbridge - please do get in touch if you're interested or would like to find out more. You don't have to commit, just come and see! This is wonderful way for Christians to be salt and light in communities.

It was great to have a group from Bearfield joining us for Wilderness Worship in April - those who came might have seen our new van - we have upgraded to a new, bigger van for our pop up youth café work and are gearing up for our two

annual pop up weeks in Trowbridge (27-31 July) and Devizes (3-7 August). We would love to see young people and any of you between 2 and 6pm! We are also holding a special evening drop-in on the evening of **Monday 27th July**, between 6 and 7.30pm, when you are ALL invited to come and see our new van, have a cold drink and chat - we'll be in Stallards Park, on your left just before the roundabout as you come in from Bradford.

Please keep us in your prayers! In particular, may we ask you to pray for:

- Discernment as we seek to recruit a new youth worker for the Trowbridge area.
- Protection and blessing for the pop up weeks.
- A real flourishing of the chaplaincy work in St Laurence as Steve takes it over, that many young people will be curious about faith and find life and meaning in Jesus.
- Wisdom as we consider how our ministry should develop in the next season.

And again, thank you! May you experience God's rich blessing as a fellowship.
