Greetings lovely Bearfielders,

During the year ahead we will be delving deeper into the Bible.

As a whole church we will be working through the Bible in order to get to know God better. The Bible Course is a springboard for us all and is especially useful for home groups, it comes with a book and online resources. The course also comes with some set readings to take us through the Bible and understand the overarching story, how it fits together and so forth. You may individually wish to supplement this with a Bible in a year plan (various plans are available online and in books). For example, if you read 3 chapters per day you will get through the whole Bible in a year, i.e. roughly 1 chapter from the New Testament, 1 from the Old Testament and a Psalm.

Preachers are invited to preach on books or passages that will be sent out with the rota. I would encourage preachers to continue to be prayerful and creative in expounding scripture. There will not be a set video and discussion in church, this will be a disappointment to some and a relief for others!

It's down to each home group to decide how the material works for the group as that is where you can best share knowledge and ask questions. You are of course encouraged to read the Bible whether you are part of a home group or not! My prayer, as we discuss together, is that the Holy Spirit will open-up the

scriptures so that we will grow in our faith and trust in Jesus. As we engage with scripture we discover more of God's heartbeat for this wonderful world and its people...

"I pray that out of his glorious riches, he may strengthen you with power through his spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith, and I pray that you being rooted and established in love may have power together with all the Lord's holy people to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God." Ephesians 3:16-19

I personally think that the Bible Course is an excellent resource and I would want to encourage the whole church to engage with it.

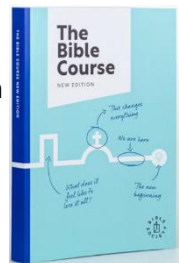
