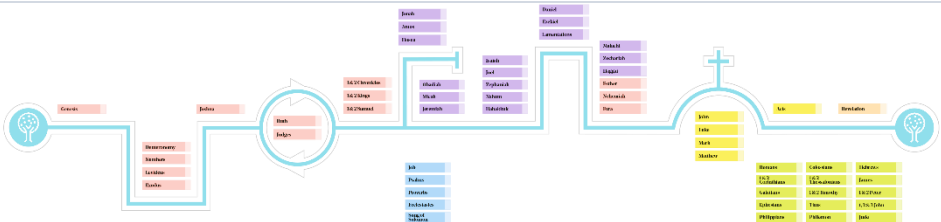

Cakes are needed to provide refreshments at the carols in the afternoon. Again let Dave or SA know if you will bake a cake or two, or if you can help serve the refreshments.

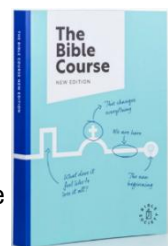


The Bible Course guidebook
