Recruitment Update

We recently held an interview weekend with Hannah, a candidate for our children youth and outreach worker vacancy. The weekend involved a number of different church members and lots of the young people. After much thought and prayer, the group decided that although we found Hannah to be smart, passionate and a genuinely lovely Christian with a love for young people, her skills were not sufficiently matched to the role and therefore we could not offer her the position as this would need a significant reworking of the role and provision of additional training and support, which as a small church we do not have the capacity to provide at this time.

Dave spoke to Hannah and explained the decision. Hannah has written to us as follows:

It was a pleasure to spend the weekend at Bearfield Church. I felt very welcomed, and I'm grateful for the opportunity to meet everyone and see how God is working among you all. I especially appreciated the conversations we had.... It was a lot to take in, but it was still a joy to be there and to meet everyone.... Please pass on my thanks to everyone at Bearfield for their warm welcome. I will be keeping all of you in my prayers. It was such an amazing experience for me .
