Bearfield Church AGM immediately after the morning service

Next Sunday - 12th May - Bearfield AGM

The intention, going forward, is to have regular three church meetings each year; the AGM in the second week of May, and two other meetings in the second weeks of October and February.

The AGM next Sunday, led by the Trustees, will be the slightly more formal of the three meetings, with reports from the Trustees, Treasurer, Leadership team and other group leaders, sharing a little of what has gone on over the year, the hopes and plans for the coming year and how the church can support practically and in prayer. (We will send round short written summaries after the AGM for those who can't attend.) AGMs will also be when church members vote for those on the leadership team (for new leaders or re-election every three years for those continuing.) Please note there are no votes due at this AGM.

The other two meetings, led by the leadership team, will be more informal meetings, with opportunities to share, discuss, suggest, question and pray together about what Bearfield is doing and how it is doing it.

Next Sunday the service will be shorter (45-50 minutes), there will be a break (10 mins) to get tea, coffee and biscuits to bring back into the church in readiness for the AGM, starting around 11.30am and taking 30-40 minutes. All are welcome.
